Skin Saver Slush -for dogs

4 Sprigs of fresh Parsley 1/4C thawed or fresh peas 3 large carrots (or 4 med) in

chunks

1 small beet in chunks

1 med. apple quartered and seeded

1 Tbsp grated ginger root or cut into

small pieces

1 cucumber, peeled chunked

(These are the core ingredients)

Optional: 1 /2 C of cabbage, broccoli,

green beans, etc.

The produce must be fresh

and RAW, the whole idea is to create

a broad spectrum of nutrients, minerals

and enzymes. Grind with 3/4

cup of water in food processor or

blender until in small pieces or pureed.

Store in refrigerator. Keeps 3-

4 days before enzymes start to break

down. If using with a smaller dog,

recipe may be halved or even quartered.

Mix in with kibble. Start with

a smaller amount then work up to

recommended level.

Small dogs: 1 tsp.

Medium dogs: 1-2 Tbsp.

Large dogs: 3-4 Tbsp.

Giant dogs: 1/2 C

Hydrochloric/ Pepsin tablet in his food. (I stick it in a blob of yogurt and it goes right down!)

The HCI/ Pepsin and live enzymes in the raw produce help your dog assimilate food and utilize it properly. The difference shows in his coat, his attitude and his energy level.

Pumpkin Shake:

(human and dog recipe, can be shared)

1/2 banana (peeled, frozen, diced)

- •~1/3 cup pumpkin puree
- •~1/3 cup plain or vanilla Greek yogurt
- •~3/4-1cup vanilla soy or almond milk (or milk of choice)
- Few shakes of pumpkin spice (Cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and allspice)
- •Few shakes of cinnamon •1tsp vanilla •4-5 ice cubes

Mix all together in blender, food processor or Smoothie machine. Cheers!



DOG and CAT Emergency Preparedness Kit

While preparing an emergency kit for yourself, please do not forget your pets. Here is a recommendation of what to put in your pet's kit:

DOGS:

- * Food and water for 1 week. Don't forget a can opener and plastic spoons if you are using canned food.
- * Plastic food bowls (you don't want to have to use precious bottled water cleaning dishes)
- * A carrier for each pet small enough to fit in one (good luck with an IW size)
- * Towels (lots of towels) to go in each carrier
- * A leash and collar with ID for each pet
- * Extra medications
- * Pet first aid kit
- * Pet waste bags
- * Photo of you and your pet together* Extra photocopies of photos of each pet
- * Copies of vaccine records

CATS:

All the above, plus-

- * Aluminum foil roasting pan to serve as disposable cat litter boxes
- * 1 week's supply of kitty litter and a scoop
